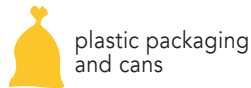

THE RULES

- **Keep** new equipment (bins and bags) **on private areas**
- **Put out** your waste from **8 pm** the evening before collection day until **5 am** on the day itself
- **Collect** your bins once they have been emptied



HOW “DOOR-TO-DOOR” WASTE COLLECTION WORKS

 non recyclable, unsorted waste	 in grey bags with unequivocal numerical code provided by the Municipality	In general, everything that doesn't go in the other 4 bins: rags, broken accessories and clothing, cigarette butts, floor dirt, rubber, small plastic objects, broken cups and plates, non-recyclable packaging, very dirty materials, non-compostable cat litter.

for non-residents (second homes)



RULES FOR THE USE OF ECOLOGICAL ISLAND



The Ecological Island is located in Menaggio, **Via Dei Cipressi n.1**



Non-resident property owners should **go to the Municipal Offices to collect the dedicated EcoCard**, valid for entry and waste disposal. **Please note that Ecological Island should be used only for short-term stays or whenever it is not possible to use the "door to door" service.**



Each property unit is entitled to **1 (one) EcoCard**



4 types of waste can be disposed of at the ecological island: **paper and cardboard, plastic packaging and cans, organic waste and non-recyclable (unsorted) dry waste**, as specified in the chart opposite



Any **glass packaging** is instead collected from freely accessible bell-shaped roadside glass bins



Waste can be taken to the Ecological Island **24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**

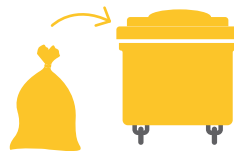

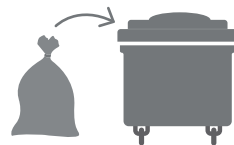

WHAT CAN GO IN

Leftover food in general, fruit, vegetables, small quantities of fresh cut flowers, stale bread, small bones, fish bones, egg shells, coffee grounds, tea and herbal tea bags, greasy or soiled paper napkins or towels, expired or rotten food without its packaging, compostable animal litter

Newspapers, books, magazines, exercise books, cardboard, cardboard boxes (such as pasta boxes), card, flyers, leaflets, drinks cartons (e.g. Tetra Pak®) free of residue, clean or slightly dirty pizza boxes

Everything that is made of plastic but that is **ONLY** packaging, such as jars, glasses and cups, plates, wrappers, plastic crisp packets, plastic coffee packs, phials, bottles, nylon, cellophane, polystyrene... metal packaging in general, aluminium and steel tins and cans, oil canisters, coffee tins, tin foil, metal tins, metal tubes, spray cans (not labelled as flammable or hazardous)

In general, everything that doesn't go in the other 4 bins: rags, broken accessories and clothing, cigarette butts, floor dirt, rubber, small plastic objects, broken cups and plates, non-recyclable packaging, very dirty materials, non-compostable cat litter.

Glass packaging in general, jars, bottles, pots

WHAT CAN'T

Plastic bags, food packaging in any material, non-compostable cat litter.

Plastic-coated paper, baking paper, coated paper, plastic packaging, till receipts.

Plastic objects that aren't packaging, pots and pans, large metal objects, electrical or electronic waste

Recyclable materials, electrical and electronic waste, hazardous waste

Light bulbs, mirrors, glazing, oven dishes, ceramic, glasses
